Notes:

*Students have flexibility in the selection of Core Curriculum courses based on the university class schedule.

The Communication Studies major is required to:

1. Complete a total of 36 credit hours in Communication Studies (CST), excluding CST 1010, only 12 of which may be from independent studies. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 15 credit hours in CST at Detroit Mercy.
2. Complete at least 15 of those 36 credit hours in courses at the 3000/4000 level.
3. Submit a portfolio in the senior year.

CST Electives: Choose at least five additional **CST courses** (15 credits). Three CST courses (excluding CST 3000 and CST 4990 which are required) must be at the 3000-4000 level.

Advising

Students must meet with their academic advisor **each semester** to have their advising hold removed. This meeting is required in order to register for classes for the upcoming term.
